EnviroNaut 2.0 builds on the success of the first EnviroNaut project, which developed the first modular online training course for the role of Environmental Officer in Nautical Tourism. This role helps the sector reduce its environmental impact and support sustainable development.

The original EnviroNaut course received very positive feedback from professional users, companies, and sector organisations. EnviroNaut 2.0 builds on this success by improving the course, increasing its use in vocational education and training (VET), developing a new Train-the-Trainer programme, and establishing recognised training and certification structures for the Nautical Tourism sector.

Develop a dedicated Train-the-Trainer programme

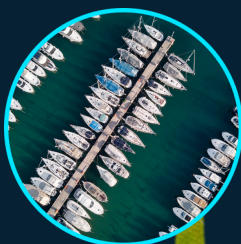

Key Results

EnviroNaut 2.0 Online Courses

The existing EnviroNaut course will be updated, expanded, integrated into a dedicated Learning Management System, and made available in additional languages (Turkish and Latvian). This will improve access, learner support, and course quality.

EnviroNaut Train-the-Trainer Programme

A state-of-the-art Train-the-Trainer programme will be developed for key Nautical Tourism subsectors including Marinas, Sea Schools & Watersport Clubs, Skippers, and Boat Maintenance companies. A multilingual handbook will support trainers.

Standardisation & Certification

EnviroNaut 2.0 will develop recognised certification and standardisation systems in cooperation with sector and certification partners. The project will also provide policy recommendations to address skills gaps in existing training programmes.



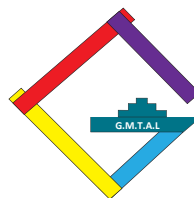
