ENVIRONAUT COURSE CURRICULUM

The main addition that the EnviroNaut project will bring to the sector is the development of the first-ever curriculum for the position of Environmental Officer in Nautical Tourism.

People qualified as Environmental Officers will bring added value to their companies, as they can help develop "sustainable nautical tourism".



ENVIRONAUT ONLINE COURSE

The curriculum will take the form of a modular online course, free of charge and accessible to everyone. All those who successfully complete the course will be awarded a European-wide qualification by the European Boating Industry as Environmental Officers.
